ART. 1

Scholarship's overview

Thanks to the support of the TOP-IX Consortium, Politecnico di Torino offers one scholarship to Extra EU and EU applicants of the 2nd level Specializing Master's Programme in "Photonics for Data Networks and Metrology" academic year 2018/2019. The gross amount is 4.000,00 Euro (four thousand/00).

The Selection's Commission will assign the scholarships during the selection process. The scholarship will be paid at the end of the lectures period (foreseen for October 2019).

ART. 2

Requirements

In order to be eligible, applicant must meet the following requirements:

- To have applied for the 2nd Level Specializing Master's programme in "Photonics for Data Networks and Metrology" for the academic year 2018/2019;
- To be ranked first in the merit list that will be published on the "Selection outcomes" page of the programme's web site at the end of the selection process

ART. 3

How scholarship is assigned

After the application deadline (September 28th 2018 at 11:59 a.m.) the Selection Committee will evaluate all the applications received and the attached documentation.

First, the Selection Committee will verify whether the applicants meet the academic requirements, have the necessary qualifications and will select those eligible to attend the Programme.

At the end of the selection process, the Selection Committee will draw up a merit list that will be published on the "Selection outcomes" page of the Specializing Master Programme's website.

The candidate who fits the above mentioned requirements will be assigned the TOP-IX scholarship. The candidate in order to be eligible for the scholarship will have to accept the internship to be carried out at TOP-IX consortium.

The Commission's evaluation shall be considered final and unquestionable.

The name of the scholarship's recipient will be published on the relevant page of the website <https://didattica.polito.it/master/photonics/2019>

The person responsible for the administrative procedure is Mr. Alberto Pusceddu (Head of the Specializing Master's Programmes and Lifelong Learning Office at Politecnico di Torino).

ART. 4

Scholarship details

The gross amount of the scholarship is 4.000,00 Euro (four thousand/00).

Scholarship recipient will have to accept the scholarship within the deadline that will be defined by the Office of Specializing Master's Programme and Lifelong Learning. He/She will receive an email with the deadline and instruction to accept the scholarship.

The scholarship may be subject to IRPEF taxation since it is considered as income equivalent to that of an employee. In order to establish the correct tax category, the student will therefore be required to fill in the form "Modulo detrazioni IRPEF" provided by the Office.

The scholarship will be paid in one instalment at the end of lectures period. The scholarship is not compatible with others scholarships offered by Politecnico di Torino for the 2018/19 academic year.

ART. 5
