QUALITY AWARD REGULATION

Each year, only students from the cycle that has just ended are considered for the award.

Preliminary Requirements for the admission of the candidates to the selection:

- ✓ With reference to the data reported in the dashboard and to the quality indicators calculated by the School of Doctorate (ScuDo):
 - 320 points of training activities, 100 points of R-50 N;
- √ The Supervisor must have approved the final thesis within six months of the end of the cycle;
- √ The Supervisor must have indicated the names of at least 4 external evaluators of the thesis.

Publications will be taken into account only as long as their date of publication falls between the beginning of the first academic year of the cycle and 6 months after the end of the cycle.

The candidates who fulfill the preliminary requirements will then by evaluated for the award.

A maximum of 100 points will be given according to the flowing criteria:

- Scientific production:
 - 3 best publications in Physics or related areas in the considered time span,
 (one of which can be replaced with a patent): up to 30 points;
 - o total scientific production index R-50N: up to 15 points;
- Judgment of the PhD Board on the overall scientific activity (oral presentations, prizes, posters, periods spent abroad, interview for admission to the final exam): up to 25 points
- Judgment of the Supervisor, of the external evaluators and of the final exam board (cum laude): up to 20 points
- Training activity (third-level credits passed with merit): 0.4 points per credit, for a maximum of 10 points.
