



Amendments to the Calls for applications for admissions in academic year 2020/21 to the Bachelor's degree programmes in

- **Engineering**
- **Design and Visual Communication**
- **Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning**
- **Architecture**
- **Professional Bachelor's degree programme in Industrial Manufacturing Technologies**

Rector's decree no. 902 dated 21th October 2020

THE RECTOR

- Having regard to the University Statute;
- Having regard to the University Teaching Regulations;
- Having regard to the resolution of the Academic Senate dated 22nd November 2016 and to the resolution of the Board of Governors dated 29th November 2016 on enrolment of applicants with an educational qualification awarded after attending only one school year in a foreign country where the period of school attendance is 12 years (provided that such qualification grants admission to a university programme in the country where the diploma is awarded), without prejudice to specific bilateral agreements.
- Having regard to Rector's decree no. 1029 dated 14th October 2019 – "Initiation of admissions procedures - Admissions to Bachelor's degree programmes with locally programmed admissions – A.Y. 2020/2021"
- Having regard to Rector's decree no. 118 dated 18th February 2020 – "Calls for applications for admissions to the Bachelor's degree programmes of the Engineering area" (hereinafter referred to as "Engineering Call");
- Having regard to Rector's decree no. 119 dated 18th February 2020 – "Calls for applications for admissions to the Bachelor's degree programme in Design and Communication" (hereinafter referred to as "Design Call");
- Having regard to Rector's decree no. 120 dated 18th February 2020 – "Calls for applications for admissions to the Bachelor's degree programme in Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning (hereinafter referred to as "Planning Call");
- Having regard to Rector's decree no. 473 dated 11th May 2020 – "Amendments to the Calls for applications for admissions to the Bachelor's degree programmes in Engineering, Design and Communication and Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning for academic year 2020/2021";
- Having regard to Rector's decree no. 617 dated 3rd July 2020 – "Calls for applications for admissions to the Bachelor's degree programme in Architettura-Architecture" for academic year 2020/2021 (hereinafter referred to as "Architecture Call") and its annexes;
- Having regard to Rector's decree no. 710 dated 23rd July 2020 – "Calls for applications for admissions to the Professional Bachelor's degree programme in Industrial Manufacturing Technologies" for academic year 2020/2021 (hereinafter referred to as "Professional Bachelor's Call");
- Considering that all the above-mentioned Calls include a specific article concerning the "enrolment process";
- Considering that the enrolment process has two phases: the first phase is online enrolment and the second phase must be completed in person at the University (students are required to go to the Office of the University Registrar or to the Incoming Mobility Office, depending on the case);
- Considering that all the above-mentioned Calls include a specific article concerning "Applicants who take multiple admission tests" and a specific Annex (Annex A or B, depending on the Call) called "Admission requirements";
- Considering that students who want to change degree programme are required to come to the University in person;
- Considering the current health emergency and the fact that the University is adopting measures to reduce the number of administrative procedures which require students to come to the University in person;
- Considering the "Procedures for entry, stay and enrolment of international/foreign students with visa in higher education courses in Italy – academic year 2020/21" dated 16th June 2020 and the information provided by Italian universities during the UNIVERSITALY webinar of 16th June 2020 (conducted by MIUR, CRUI, CIMEA, MAECI and the Ministry of Internal Affairs) in order to encourage international students who



need an entry visa to pre-enrol in university programmes, it is necessary to modify the definition of “quota students” provided by the Calls referred to in Rector’s decrees no. 118, 119, 120;

DECREES

ART. 1

Rector’s decrees no. 118, 119, 120, 617 and 710 are amended as follows:

Rector’s decree no. 118 – ENGINEERING CALL updated in accordance with Rector’s decree no. 473 of 11.05. 2020

ART.12 (Enrolment process)

1. The requirements for enrolment in the Bachelor’s degree programmes of the Engineering area are illustrated in Annex B and Annex C to the Engineering Call, of which they are integral parts.
2. During the enrolment process, all students are required to complete a phase in which they pay the first instalment of their tuition fees and receive their Student Number (see next paragraph 3). This phase is different for each of the following categories of students (see “Enrolment Process” Table):
 - Students with an Italian educational qualification who have been identified during the TIL-I test (Test in Laib – Ingegneria) and whose personal information has already been checked by Politecnico;
 - Students with an Italian educational qualification who have NOT been identified during the TIL-I test and whose personal information has not been checked by Politecnico;
 - Students with a non-Italian educational qualification.
3. First phase - online enrolment: the provisions of paragraph 3 of Rector’s decree no. 118 (as amended by Rector’s decree no. 473) remain in force integrally.
4. Each category of students referred to in paragraph 2 must complete the enrolment process following the instructions provided in the “Enrolment Process” Table attached to the present document.

Rector’s decree no. 119 – DESIGN AND VISUAL COMMUNICATION CALL updated in accordance with Rector’s decree no. 473 of 11.05. 2020

ART.11 (Enrolment process)

1. The requirements for enrolment in the Bachelor’s degree programme in Design and Communication are illustrated in Annex A and Annex B to the Design Call, of which they are integral parts.
2. During the enrolment process, all students are required to complete a phase in which they pay the first instalment of their tuition fees and receive their Student Number (see next paragraph 3). This phase is different for each of the following categories of students (see “Enrolment Process” Table):
 - Students with an Italian educational qualification who have been identified during the TIL-D test (Test in Laib – Design) and whose personal information has already been checked by Politecnico;
 - Students with an Italian educational qualification who have NOT been identified during the TIL test and whose personal information has not been checked by Politecnico;



- Students with a non-Italian educational qualification.

3. First phase - online enrolment: the provisions of paragraph 3 of Rector's decree no. 119 (as amended by Rector's decree no. 473) remain in force integrally.

4. Each category of students referred to in paragraph 2 must complete the enrolment process following the instructions provided in the "Enrolment Process Table" attached to the present document.

**Rector's decree no. 120 – TERRITORIAL, URBAN, ENVIRONMENTAL AND LASCAPE PLANNING CALL
updated in accordance with Rector's decree no. 473 of 11.05. 2020**

ART.11 (Enrolment process)

1. The requirements for enrolment in the Bachelor's degree programme in Territorial, Urban, Environmental and Landscape Planning are illustrated in Annex A and Annex B to the Planning Call, of which they are integral parts.

2. During the enrolment process, all students are required to complete a phase in which they pay the first instalment of their tuition fees and receive their Student Number (see next paragraph 3). This phase is different for each of the following categories of students (see "Enrolment Process" Table):

- Students with an Italian educational qualification who have been identified during the TIL-P test (Test in Laib – Planning) and whose personal information has already been checked by Politecnico;
- Students with an Italian educational qualification who have NOT been identified during the TIL test and whose personal information has not been checked by Politecnico;
- Students with a non-Italian educational qualification.

3. First phase - online enrolment: the provisions of paragraph 3 of Rector's decree no. 120 (as amended by Rector's decree no. 473) remain in force integrally.

4. Each category of students referred to in paragraph 2 must complete the enrolment process following the instructions provided in the "Enrolment Process" Table attached to the present document.

Rector's decree no. 617 – ARCHITECTURE CALL

ART.14 (Enrolment process)

1. The requirements for enrolment in the Bachelor's degree programme in Architettura-Architecture are illustrated in Annex A and Annex B to the Call, of which they are integral parts.

2. During the enrolment process, all students are required to complete a phase in which they pay the first instalment of their tuition fees and receive their Student Number (see next paragraph 3). This phase is different for each of the following categories of students (see "Enrolment Process" Table):

- Students with an Italian educational qualification who have been identified during the TIL-A test (online admission test - Architecture) and whose personal information has already been checked by Politecnico;
- Students with an Italian educational qualification who have NOT been identified during the TIL test and whose personal information has not been checked by Politecnico;
- Students with a non-Italian educational qualification.

3. First phase - online enrolment: the provisions of paragraph 3 of Rector's decree no. 617 and further amendments remain in force integrally.



4. Each category of students referred to in paragraph 2 must complete the enrolment process following the instructions provided in the “Enrolment Process” Table attached to the present document.

Rector's decree no. 710 – PROFESSIONAL BACHELOR'S CALL

ART.9 (Enrolment process)

1. The requirements for enrolment in the Professional Bachelor's degree programme in Industrial Manufacturing Technologies are illustrated in Annex A to the Call, of which it is integral part.

2. During the enrolment process, all students are required to complete a phase in which they pay the first instalment of their tuition fees and receive their Student Number (see next paragraph 3). This phase is different for each of the following categories of students (see “Enrolment Process” Table):

- Students with an Italian educational qualification who have been identified during the TIL-LP test (online admission test – Laurea Professionalizzante) and whose personal information has already been checked by Politecnico;
- Students with an Italian educational qualification who have NOT been identified during the TIL test and whose personal information has not been checked by Politecnico;
- Students with a non-Italian educational qualification.

3. First phase - online enrolment: the provisions of paragraph 3 of Rector's decree no. 710 remain in force integrally.

4. Each category of students referred to in paragraph 2 must complete the enrolment process following the instructions provided in the “Enrolment Process” Table attached to the present document.
