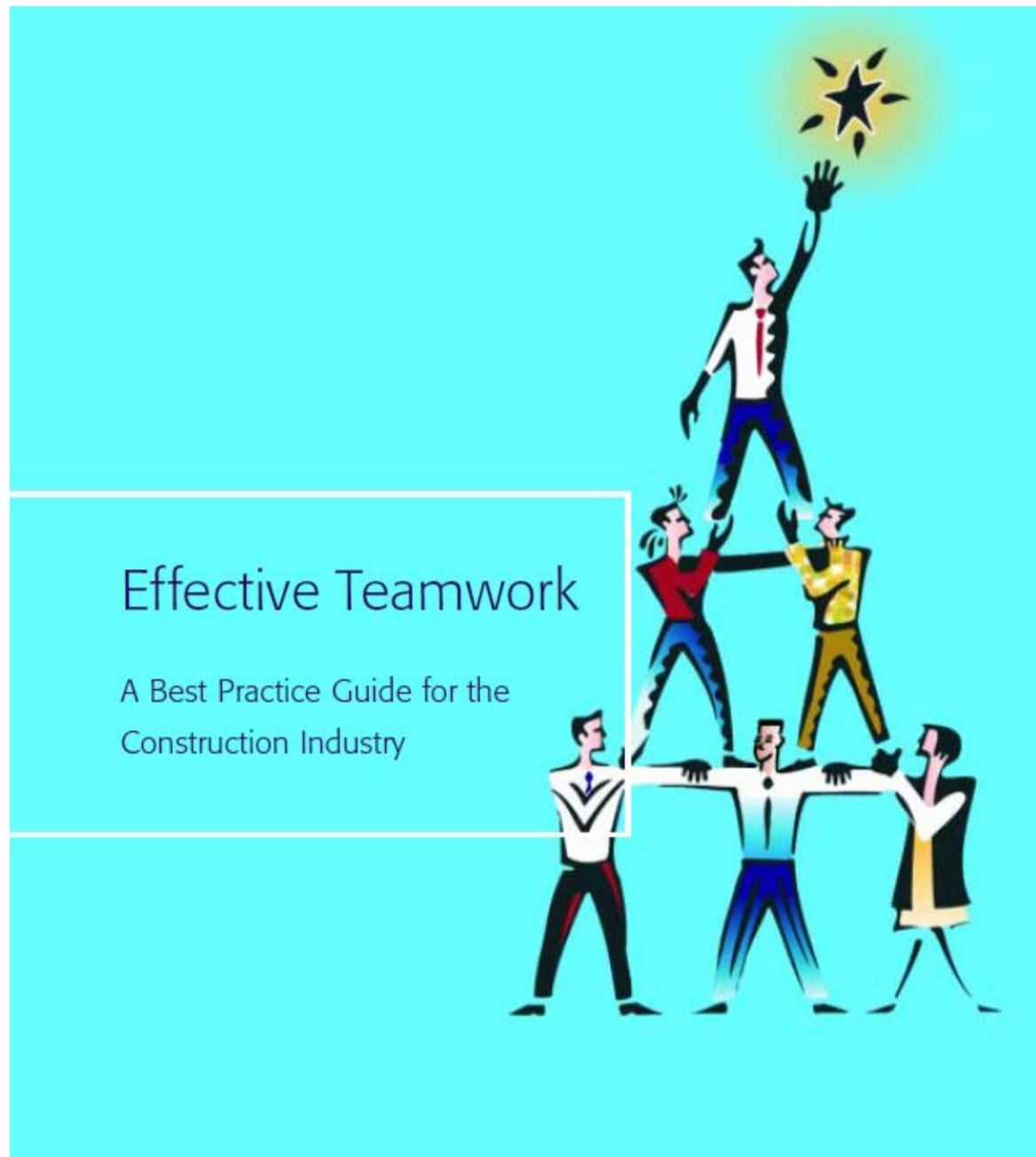

Once you leave university, you will find that most projects of any significance are delivered not by individuals working alone, but by teams of people working together. Often team members will have **different experience** or even **different expertise**, for example in **architecture, planning** or **engineering**.

Ideally a team's project proposals represent the combined knowledge and intelligence of all the team members. But in practice, this ideal may not be met. Simply putting a group of individuals together does not necessarily result in effective collaboration.

In this workshop, you will be introduced to some of the principles of **successful teamwork** such as developing a shared vision, encouraging team identity, good communication, and how to resolve conflict. And you will be encouraged to reflect on your own experiences of working in a team, to assess how effective it was.
