Community-led local development is a specific tool of the European Commission for use at sub-regional level, which is complementary to other development support at local level. It is an approach that turns traditional “top down” development policy on its head and is aimed at encouraging cooperation between the public, private and civil society sectors.

Under CLLD, local people take the reins and form a local partnership that designs and implements an integrated development strategy.

The strategy is designed to build on the community’s social, environmental and economic strengths or “assets” rather than simply compensate for the problems.
