RULES FOR THE ENROLMENT IN THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES OF THE ENGINEERING AREA FOR A.Y.2017/18 FROM 13 MARCH 2017

As specified in the Call for Admissions to the Bachelor's Degree Programmes of the Engineering Area, European Union students, Equivalent students, Quota students and Assimilated students who passed the guaranteed thresholds can enrol for the a.y.2017/18 before:

- 2:00 pm of Monday 4th September
- 2:00 pm of Wednesday 20th September 2017 (<u>deadline only for Quota candidates</u>)

Attending the lessons and/or viewing the lecture recordings

After enrolment students are allowed to attend the courses still ongoing after the date of their enrolment.

Students can <u>view the recordings of the lectures</u> of all the first-year courses as well (first and second-semester courses), excepted those of the English Language course and, if the chosen degree programme is entirely or partially taught in English, those of the *Linear Algebra and Geometry* course.

Please Note: the only available lecture recordings made available for the students intending to enrol in the **Bachelor's Degree Programme in Industrial Production Engineering** are those of the courses of *Analisi Matematica I* and of *Informatica*. The lecture recordings of the other first-year courses is not offered.

The earliest possible exam session is the summer session (June/July 2017).
