Minimal instructions to get started with the "toptesi" LaTeX template

- 1) make sure that you have an updated LaTeX distribution on your system
- 1a) download and install a COMPLETE distribution ("texlive" for Linux, "MacTex" for Mac, or "MiKTeX" for Windows)
- 1b) after installation, make sure to update the distribution and all packages (follow the post-install instructions)
- 2) download and uncompress the toptesi-scudo-example folder, by preserving subfolder structure
- 3) perform the first compilation of the template: issue the following commands either from a shell (Linux, Max or Windows) or from the graphical interface (TeXShop, TeXWorks, etc...) after you open the file toptesi-scudo-example.tex

pdflatex toptesi-scudo-example.tex biber toptesi-scudo-example pdflatex toptesi-scudo-example.tex pdflatex toptesi-scudo-example.tex

You should obtain the pdf file toptesi-scudo-example.pdf plus other additional files with the same base name and various extensions (.blg, .bbl, and many others)

4) On your system, you can find a complete documentation of the toptesi package at (your software versions may be different, so some folder names might change)
